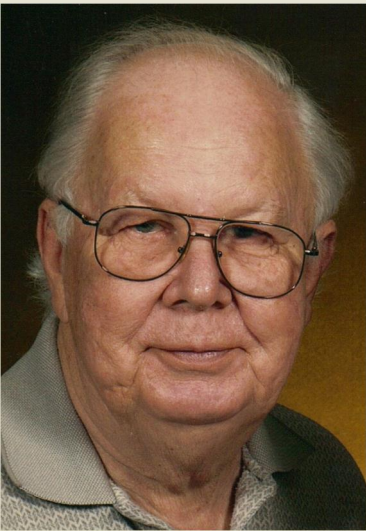

**Ray
